
*Hi, I am your favourite car.






*I love it when we drive on the highway, where we can go really fast. But no matter how much I love speed, I make sure that I stay in check.

I feel squeaky clean.






Deep inside the car, there live some gentle giants...

The airbags protect and cushion the adults sitting in the front. But their power is too strong for children; they will hurt a child if they inflate onto them.


